### NOTICE TO AUTHORS

**Scope.** *Proceedings* series A publishes papers on any aspect of mathematical and physical sciences, including chemistry and engineering. Short papers are especially welcome (up to 10 printed pages; for example, equivalent to about 5000 words and 3 figures), and if accepted are normally published within three months of receipt at the Society. These should contain reports of completed work; preliminary reports ('letters') are not encouraged.

**Submission.** Authors may send their papers (i) direct to the Editorial Office, whose address is given below, (ii) to one of the Regional Editors listed above, or (iii) via a Fellow or Foreign Member of the Society. The Editor will, in reaching a decision, take into account the comments of referees and, if route (iii) is chosen, the recommendation of the Fellow or Foreign Member. Authors are invited to suggest the names of referees, with the understanding that such suggestions are not necessarily adopted. Three copies of the typescript and figures are required, and originals of any figures should also be submitted. Papers should be prepared in accordance with the 'Instructions to authors' printed at the end of every volume of *Proceedings* A and available from the Editorial Office.
