The Editor will, in reaching a decision, take into account the comments of referees. Authors are invited to suggest the names of referees, with the understanding that such suggestions are not necessarily adopted. Three copies of the typescript and figures are required, and originals of any figures should also be submitted. Papers should be prepared in accordance with the 'Instructions to authors' printed at the end of every volume of *Proceedings A* and available from the Editorial Office.
